Staffing: We are still expecting our first passport USA RN in July. We currently have the following openings:

RN's- **ED**= 0.3 nightshift; **BC**- per diem; **MSP**- per diem; **ICU**- 0.6 nights, 0.9FTE nights; **PACU**- 0.8; **Surgery** 0.8FTE. Other: **RT**= 0.8FTE. **Surgery Tech**- 0.8FTE, 1.0FTE

We hope to create understanding of our barriers to treating BH patients. I also have a meeting scheduled with Community Lifeline over discharge concerns they have and to create a better understanding of the services we offer. 





Negotiations: The Union negotiating team and Mason leadership won't come together again until May 25th.

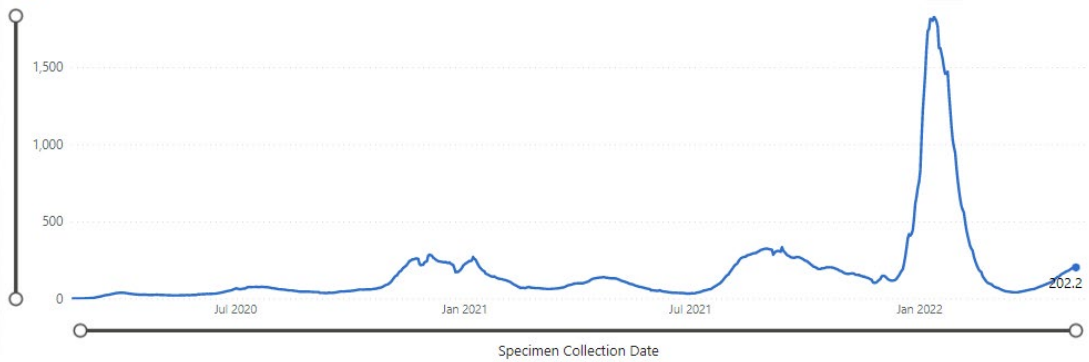
