



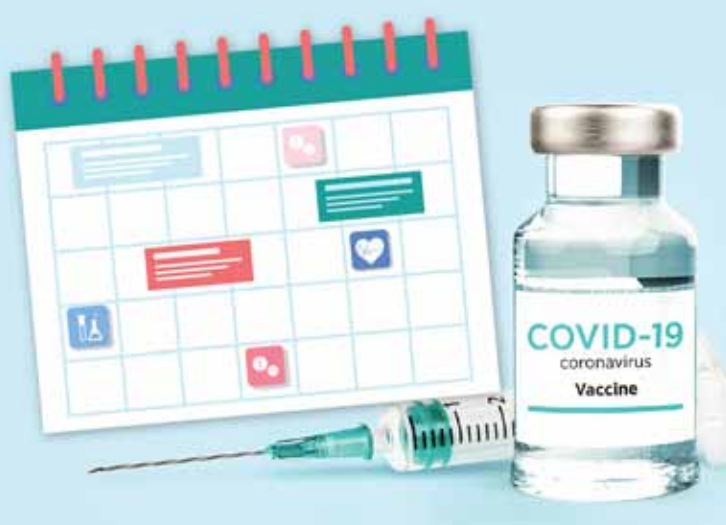

If you are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine in Washington state, visit our website and look for the link to schedule your vaccine. **Please remember to fill out and bring your consent form to the appointment. Download it via our website.**

Now Scheduling COVID-19 Vaccines!



To receive a vaccination through Mason Health or Mason County Public Health, you must be a Mason County resident, work in Mason County or be an established patient at Mason Health. Mason Health is supporting Mason County's planned mass vaccination drive-thru events and pre-scheduled community

events. Schedule a time at a mass vaccine event by visiting Mason County's website at www.co.mason.wa.us.

If you or someone you know is having a hard time signing up for an appointment using a computer, please contact the Mason County Senior Center at 360-426-7374. Mason Health is providing regular vaccine clinics at the Senior Center.

- People over 50 living in a multigenerational household
- Educators and staff, Pre K - 12th Grade
- Child care workers
- High-risk workers in congregate settings, such as agriculture, food processing, grocery stores, public transit and correctional facilities
- People 16 or older who are pregnant or have a disability that puts them at high risk for severe COVID-19 illness

Visitor Restrictions and Closures

- MGH **Cafeteria** is open to authorized visitors only.
- **Updated!** The **Patient Accounts** and **Billing Office** is now **open to the public** and is located next to McDonald's. Call 360-427-3601 (or 360-275-8614 from Allyn) if you need help paying your bill or pay online at www.masongeneral.com/payyourbill.
- Only 1 person is allowed at a time in the **Health Information Management Office/Medical Records**. Call ahead for your records at 360-427-9857.
- **Mason General Hospital Foundation** and the **Mason Health Development Office** is open by appointment only. Call 360-427-3623 for service.
- The **Learning Center** is closed to the public and there are no community classes scheduled at this time.
