COVID-19 Vaccine Information

On Dec. 17, Mason Health received 975 doses of the COVID-19 immunization. We will be immunizing all individuals in Phase 1A first, which includes workers in health care settings and long-term care facilities.

- All **community meetings, classes and support groups** have been cancelled until further notice.

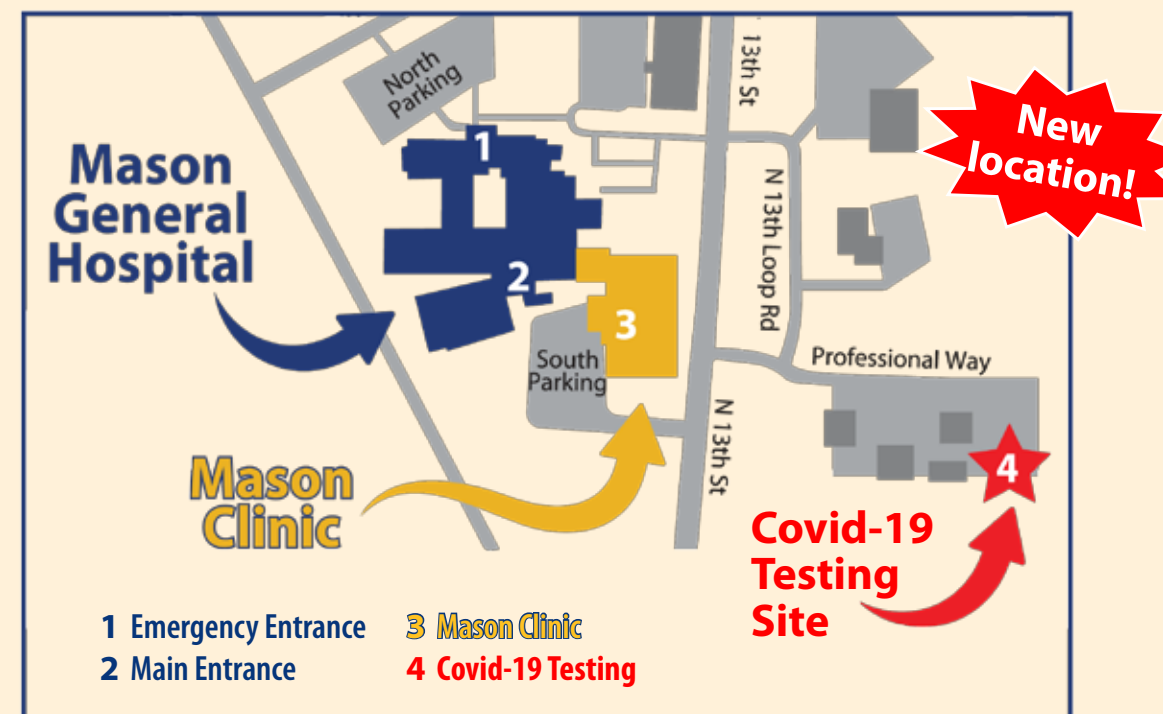
These offices at Gateway Center have limited availability:

Covid-19 Testing Update

Testing for COVID-19 has moved indoors. Service is now provided at the former pediatric clinic location. Make a reservation by calling the triage line at **360-427-3615**. Once you arrive, park in a reserved parking space and call **360-427-4428** to check in.

The hours have remained the same: Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., closed 1 to 1:30 p.m. for lunch.



Mason Health has opened a new care clinic next door to the COVID-19 testing site. This clinic will be focused on diagnosing and treating patients who have symptoms of COVID-19 and is located at the former MGH Oakland Bay Pediatrics in a separate, closed-off location from the testing area.

If you have an appointment for COVID-19 care at Oakland Bay Primary Care, park in a reserved stall once you arrive, remain in your vehicle and call **360-427-3631** to check in.
