Mason Health offers flu and COVID vaccinations at the Mason Health Vaccine

Clinic (red square on map below) by appointment only at <https://calendly.com/masonhealth>.


We have a high volume of appointments, so please be patient and expect delays when scheduling.

Vaccines can also be scheduled with your primary care provider, pediatrician or at your local pharmacy. To schedule an appointment with your primary care provider or pediatrician at Mason Clinic, call **360-426-2653**. The flu vaccine may be taken at the same time as the COVID-19 vaccine.

All Washingtonians **ages 5 and older are eligible for COVID-19 vaccination.** Only patients 12 and older can be scheduled at the Mason Health Vaccine Clinic; please schedule younger patients at an appointment with their pediatrician.

COVID treatment is located at a separate clinic on Professional Way (see red triangle on map), while **COVID testing** is available through a Curative testing kiosk (red dot).

- For COVID-19 Testing and Vaccination Information, please go to our website or contact your provider.
- Alternate care sites are in place for high-risk patients.
- Plexiglass barriers are in place to protect patients and staff.
- Gateway Center locations have restricted community access. Medical Records and Business Offices are open; patients are encouraged to call first and adhere to all safety precautions. Foundation/Development Office is open by appointment only.
