Mason Health has administered more than 21,593 doses of COVID-19 vaccine to date!

As of May 12, all Washingtonians ages 12 and older are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccination, following announcements from the Department of Health and CDC. Mason Health is providing vaccinations through our vaccine clinic, as well as at community outreach events.

Please note – parental consent/permission and completed consent forms are required prior to vaccination for all vaccine patients under the age of 18.
