- Funds are allocated to Mason County residents only
- Expanded services in 2017 to include diagnosis and treatment of Ovarian, Uterine, Endometrial, Breast and Cervical cancers, along with the Gardasil Vaccine to prevent the HPV Virus

Who Qualifies:

Mason County Residents that are:

- **Uninsured**
- **Under-insured**
- **Have financial Need**

If you or someone you know are receiving treatment at Mason General Hospital & Family of Clinics, you may qualify for assistance for the diagnosis and treatment of Breast, Cervical, Ovarian, Uterine or Endometrial cancers, including insurance deductibles and co-pays and transportation out of the area for radiation and chemotherapy.

What the Fund Pays:

If you qualify, KHCF will pay:

- **Diagnoses and treatment** of Breast, Cervical, Ovarian, Uterine or Endometrial cancer up to \$13,000 a year
- **Insurance deductible and co-pays**
- **Transportation** out of the area for radiation and chemotherapy



Mason County who have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer get the help they need.

To help meet this need, they went to the Mason General Hospital Foundation with seed money to start a Chapter empowered to raise funds for breast and cervical cancer diagnoses and treatment.
