Establishing the Fund

Karen Hilburn, a longtime Shelton resident, was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2002. While undergoing treatment, Karen was struck by the amount of emotional and financial turmoil she and her family went through. Fortunately, Karen had good health insurance and was able to undergo treatment without it being a financial burden. Karen and her husband, Scott, made a decision to help women living in Mason County who have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer get the help they need.

To help meet this need, they went to the Mason General Hospital Foundation with seed money to start a Chapter empowered to raise funds for breast and cervical cancer diagnoses and treatment.

About the Fund

Established in 2004, the mission of the Karen Hilburn Breast & Cervical Cancer Fund (KHB&CCF) is to help women with medical expenses for breast or cervical cancer, as well as assist with its prevention through testing and promoting awareness.

Mason County residents that are

- uninsured
- underinsured
- have financial need

What the Fund Pays

If you qualify, KHB&CCF will pay:

- Diagnoses and treatment of breast or cervical cancer up to \$13,000 a year
- Insurance deductible and co-pays
- Transportation out of the area for radiation and chemotherapy

Your financial gift to the KHB&CCF will go toward funding breast cancer and cervical cancer diagnoses and treatment for local uninsured or underinsured women who live in Mason County.
