## Patients and Visitors:

To continue to provide high level care and protect our patients and staff, we have begun limiting visitors and screening people entering Mason Health for signs of fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose or shortness of breath. Patients receiving services will also be screened and provided a mask, if necessary. The cafeteria, gift shop and Gateway location offices are closed to the public until further notice. ### Visitor Guidelines:

- We request that you limit the number of visitors to 1 a day.
- Please use the south entrance to the hospital (Main Entrance).
- We request that if you have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, or a runny nose that you delay your visit until you are feeling better.
- If your loved one is giving birth or in the end stages of their life, please call the nursing department to arrange for special accommodations.
- We request that you wash your hands often with soap and water.

## Health Alert!

### If you have symptoms such as:

- **Fever**

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Wash your hands with soap and water regularly for at least 20 seconds. Alcohol hand sanitizers are also effective.
- Try not to touch your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Stay home when you are sick (except to get medical care). Keep sick children home from school.
- Cough or sneeze into a tissue or your elbow. If you use a tissue, wash your hands afterward.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
