Once the program is completed, students will be eligible to take their state licensing exam. Once licensed, students will have the opportunity to obtain a job as a laboratory assistant at Mason Health Laboratory, at either full-time or per diem status.

- Have a High School Diploma or equivalent
- Graduate from Shelton High School Health Science Academy with a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Meet all Mason Health pre-employment requirements
- Be able to perform the duties of the position
